

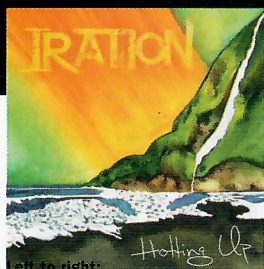
In the Mix

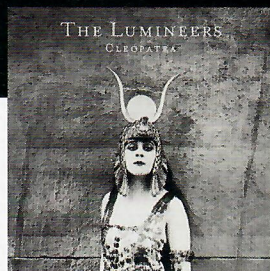

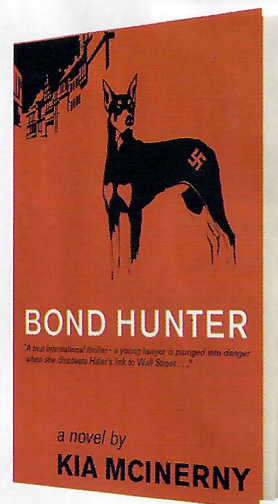
LIFT Off

U.S. ELEVATOR, the Santa Barbara-based band spearheaded by Johnny Irion, released their self-titled debut album last November. Well known for the folk music he makes with partner and wife Sarah Lee Guthrie (daughter of Arlo and granddaughter of Woody), Irion's latest venture is unquestionably rock. After meeting filmmaker, cinematographer, and photographer Alan Kozlowski—who provided the 24-track Studer A80 recorder that makes the bands heavily '60s-influenced sound possible—and the addition of bassist Nate Modisette, drummer Erich Riedl, guitarist Anders Bergstrom, pianist Brett Long, and producer Tim Bluhm, the group began playing together in the spring of 2014, and last February recorded in Modisette's cabin in Mission Hills. The exploratory album, which is bookended with instrumental pieces named for the Montecito coffee spot Pierre Lafond, was written and recorded live without headphones. Local speaker giant Sonos also played a role lining the house with speakers for recording and sponsoring an album launch party at Soho. c.b.
